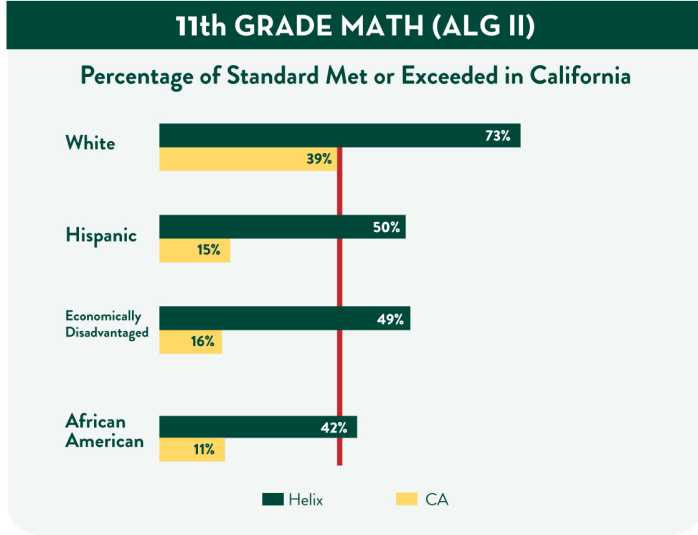
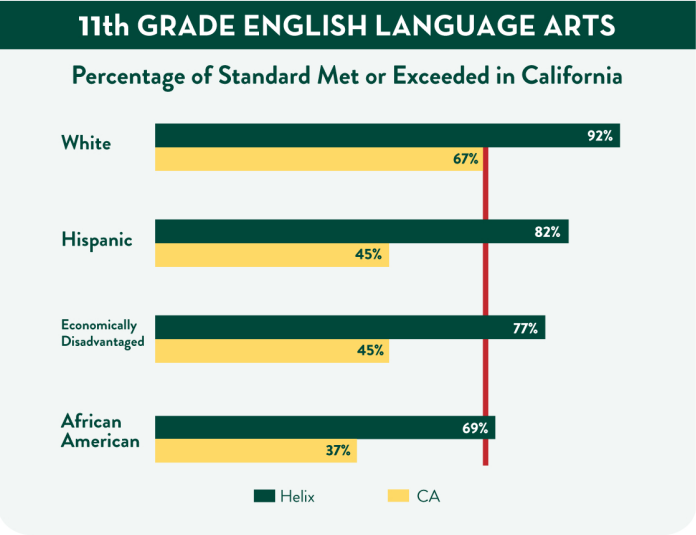
Helix defies the odds by closing the achievement gap for Black, Brown, and economically disadvantaged students.

Comprehensive high schools throughout the nation have long underserved Black, Brown, and economically disadvantaged students. For decades, the clarion call for educators to close the achievement gap has largely gone unanswered, as shown in the graphs below.

2022 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)



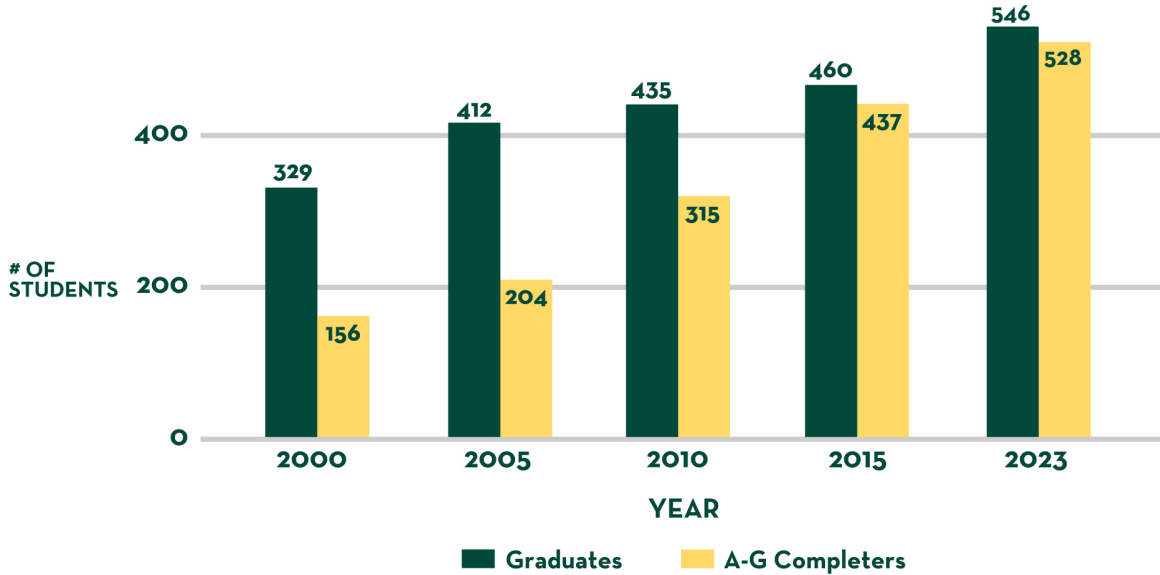

The red line indicates the performance of the highest performing subgroup (White) in California as compared to all the other Helix student subgroups. The graph indicates that all Helix subgroups outperformed White students in California in 2022.

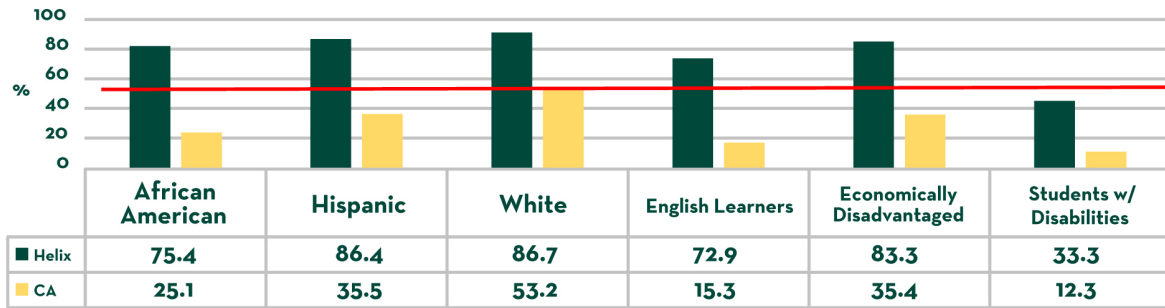
Helix Graduates and A-G Completers
